

Summer school

"Perspectives for Young Researchers in Science and Education"

We invite applications for a summer school, funded by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) from 22.08.-31.08.2016. This will start with visits to European Institutions in Strasburg, followed by lectures and presentations in Essen.

During the summer school, lectures will be presented covering the following subjects:

- Career perspectives for young researchers in European science
- Democratic structures in science
- Ethically correct scientific research
- Ethical rules for publications
- Science theory
- International cooperation
- Development of the Bologna-process
- Equal opportunities for women and men in science
- Diversity management
- Different political systems in the world, not also with respect to science
- Funding possibilities for young researchers
- The European scientific systems (research at universities, at research institutions, in industry; European and national players and structures)
- Language tests (German, English) as a basis for international research

There will be a lot of time for discussion, and there will be opportunities for all participants to interact with lecturers, organizers, and other participants.

Language

Good English knowledge is required for all participants. This has to be documented, e.g. by a DAAD language test or by a Skype interview after the application.

Application:

The summer school is open for young researchers from Belarus, Poland and Ukraine. The participants should hold a University degree (at least a master or a comparable qualification). There is no limit with respect to the subject; invitations from all faculties are invited. **All expenses (travel, living expenses, accommodation in double rooms) will be paid by the organizers.** About 20 participants will be funded. It is expected that each applicant will participate in the whole summer school. Typically, applicants should not be older than 35 years.
